Will my life change after having a stent?

Will I need to have my stent removed?

What are the risks associated post-procedure?

How can I lower my risk of complications?

What signs and symptoms should I watch for?

How will I know that my stent is working properly?

Should I follow a special diet after my procedure?

What other lifestyle modifications or steps can I take to help my heart recover?
